## HOW TO REGISTER TO RUN FOR AN ELECTED POSITION

# **1.) Confirm Eligibility**

When deciding what elected position you would like to run for, you must first confirm your qualifications and be able to pay the filing fee. A full list of offices, qualifications, and filing fees are available <u>here</u>.

# 2.) Complete KY Registry of Election Finance (KREF)

This is where you list the amount of money you plan to spend on your campaign. There are two different welcome packets; one for those planning to raise or spend less than \$3,000, and one for more than \$3,000.

\*As of 2020, this registration must be completed online. It must also be printed & submitted with the form below.

# 3.) Select Your Office & Complete Registration

There are multiple offices available to run for. Each has a specific form that needs to be filed. Download and complete the registration file.

a.) Click here to visit <u>elect.ky.gov</u>
b.) Click "Becoming a Candidate"
c.) Click "Candidate Filing Forms"
d.) Click "Continue"

e.) Click I am interested in information regarding "Filing for an elected office"
f.) Choose your position... i.e. Mayor, Judge, Sheriff, etc.

## 4.) Submit your registration at identified location

Each registration has a submission location listed on the document. Most need to be printed (along with your KREF) and submitted.

### HOW TO REGISTER TO RUN FOR CITY COUNCIL

#### 1.) Determine what Ward you live in



This is the only Ward you are eligible to run in.

#### 3.) Download the correct form

- a. Go to KY Secretary of State <u>here</u>
- b. Click "Continue"
- c. Click I am interested in information regarding: **"Filing for an elected office"**
- d. I want filing forms for "**City Legislative Body"** (this means City Council)
- e. This filing is for a: "Nonpartisan not waiving primary"
- f. Click to download or direct link <u>here</u>

#### 2.) Complete KY Registry of Election Finance (KREF) form

\*This is where you list the amount of money you plan to spend on your campaign.

- a. Step by step instructions to file electronically click <u>here</u>
- b. Here is a list of forms to welcome candidates & aid in your registration decisions - <u>select "Candidates"</u>
- c. If you have questions while registering, call 502.573.2226

#### 4.) Complete the form

Example: For Completing the **Nominating Petition** form for the 2022 election in Somerset/Pulaski County -

- a. 'To "Linda Burnett" Commonwealth of KY, "Pulaski" County:'
- b. The date is 'to be held on "May 17, 2022" (if there are less than 3 candidates registering for office, you will automatically move to the Nov. ballot)
- c. ...'The candidate for the office of
   "Somerset City Council" district "Ward XX" (the number of the ward you live in)
- d. You need 2 witnesses that live within your Ward to be petitioners on your form.

#### 5.) Finalize Registration

- a. Print forms (Nominating Petition and KREF)
- b. Have your petitioners and yourself sign the **Nominating Petition** form

#### 6.) Submit Forms

- a. Take printed **Nominating Petition** and **KREF** forms to your County Clerk's office: Election Department
- b. Pay \$50 registration fee
