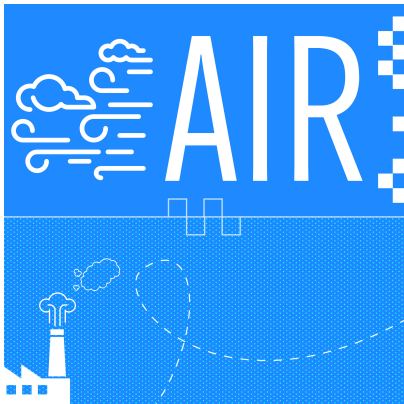


DOES YOUR COMMUNITY HAVE AN ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERN?
